4. Formal

a. Budget amendments for formal subsidy (Rama)

- i. PPT with update was shared can be found in Finance folder
 - Breakdown of budget reallocation proposal was explained
- ii. Questions
 - We had >\$1800 left over from past TMMSA councils; don't we have to leave next year's council some money?
 a. We will be leaving them \$600 of emergency funds
 - 2. Why haven't we asked Dr. Lee for the class composite money?
 - a. He is going to help us pay for it; but he will not give us the money and hope that we use it for the composite
 - 3. How are we on the other avenues of funding?
 - a. We're going to hear back from CVUO around the week of the $20^{\rm th}$
 - 4. What guarantees that we get the money in spring/fall, if we're not guaranteed this year?
 - a. Our budget went out very rushed this year
 - Also, this year, they got more budget
 requests worth \$150,000 and they only have
 \$50,000 to distribute
 - b. If next year's council puts more time into their budget proposal, they have a better chance of securing funding
 - We've also already established ourselves as an association; fewer steps next year

- c. However, there are no guarantees on funding
- 5. Can we subsidize tickets to \$70 or \$75 instead?

a. TBD

- iii. Discussion
 - Amendments to funding of all items besides class composite - No objections
 - 2. Amendment to class composite funding:
 - a. Tamara: objection; this composite is for the 4th year cohort; if we were to ask people to raise funds for formal, both cohorts would help; if we ask people to help raise funds for the composite, only 4th years would be helping; subsidizing the remaining tickets is not worth losing our class composite
 - b. Marah: objection; it doesn't feel like it's our place to make this decision about the class composite on behalf of the cohort; people expect a class composite when they graduate, it's more important than an optional formal
 - c. Maryam: neutral
 - We're already in a tough situation in terms of finances, I don't think we should be leaving next year's council in a more difficult situation than we are in
 - ii. On the other hand, it's ridiculous that we have to pay for the class composite to begin with. It should be covered by our tuition - we should push for this
 - iii. It's not fair that those who missed out on the first sale should pay \$80 - it's a lot of money, we're all students
 - We want to make sure that everyone has the opportunity to participate at a fair price

- d. Dalia: in favor; we don't have to choose between class composite and subsidizing formal; We can subsidize formal with this money now, and over the spring and the fall, next year's council can apply for CVUO funding; If we can raise the \$600 for the composite with CVUO funds or fundraising events before the year ends, then it works out perfectly
- e. Rama: I'm not comfortable with the idea of the class composite potentially not happening; we shouldn't leave the responsibility to raise the funds for our composite on next year's council (last year's council left us the money for theirs)
