### b. VP External (David)

  - 1. In contact with Harry
  - Went to one meeting; it was just a meet and greet, discussed general ideas of what they want implemented this year
  - Mays is representing the TMMSA at SACC meetings
     a. will be working under someone and helping her
    - with her project
  - Hopeful to create a big change for the TMM student body
  - Wants to implement environmentally-friendly practices within TMM
    - a. E.g. mask recycling bin in PMD similar to the one in RGN
- 4. Proposal (Yasmine)

- a. Proposal for an EDI committee
  - i. Goal: promote EDI, plan events, apply for grants and funding opportunities
  - Members: EDI coordinator, VP Academics, 4 council members (optional: recruitment, bilingualism, 3<sup>rd</sup> year reps), 4 noncouncil members

1. Unlimited guest seats

- iii. Vision for committee: create a space for people to share ideas about EDI so that they can use these ideas and implement them in their respective associations/clubs, etc.
  - With the council being started by TMMSA students, this will help the TMM students/community first and foremost
- iv. What can this committee add that the TMMSA hasn't already accomplished?
  - Provide a space for students to share issues related to EDI (e.g. SASS, Francophonie, etc. which are areas that have been lacking for a while)
  - There are a lot of other issues that we don't know about because we don't have a space for students to share those issue
- v. How is this going to be different from the FoM EDI committee?
  - 1. FoM committee focuses on a larger scale
  - This committee really wants to be close to the students and take their input and concerns into account
- vi. How are you going to make sure that you have representations from all the subpopulations form uottawa?
  - There is space for everyone to join but people will only join if you want to make a change
  - There is space for anyone to come in and share their concerns, even if they don't want to be part of the change

- vii. How does this affect Yasmine's role as EDI coordinator?
  - EDI committee will not take away from her role; she will still be planning events and fulfilling her role.
  - It will lessen the load of addressing all aspects of EDI because Yasmine is only one person and cannot represent everyone
  - **3.** This committee will allow us to harness the skillsets within our community to do EDI justice
- viii. Vote Motion to allow this committee to proceed as
  presented
  - 1. Results: 10 votes in favor, 1 vote against
  - 2. Motion passed

# 5. Budget 2021-2022 (Rama)

- a. Budget can be found in Finance folder on Teams
  - i. There is also money coming in from locker rentals
  - ii. Apparel is being sold at a small profit some money coming in from there as well
  - iii. Rama will find a way to reflect these profits into the budget

#### 6. Varia

#### a. Stemness Office (Tamara)

- i. There are two offices beside the TMMSA Office; they are intended to be a study space that can be booked by students.
- ii. Tamara runs a not-for-profit called The Stemness View
  - They reached out to Dr. Lee to request to use one of the offices for the Stemness view.
  - He said the offices belong to the TMMSA; it is up to us as a council to give the space out.
- iii. Stemness view aims to showcase diversity within STEM. They do this by publishing magazines targeted at high school and early university students.
  - iv. Office space is needed for team to work out of. By borrowing/leasing the office, it would belong to the stemness view for the year.

- v. Two proposals:
  - Rental (with \$\$): Stemness view pays to rent out space for the year; money extra profit that can be used by TMMSA
  - Sponsorship (no payment): TMMSA would get a spot within the journal; way for us to promote TMM to prospective students
- vi. Concerns about the space being given to a TMMSA council member (appearance of favoritism, Tamara has access to the TMMSA council and therefore has more information than the average student, etc.)
  - Tamara approached Dr. Lee as a TMM student, not a TMMSA council members. If any other TMM student were to reach out to Dr. Lee, they could've also been redirected to discuss this with TMMSA
    - a. We didn't know that these rooms belonged to us until Dr. Lee told us; after he was asked
  - Maryam: to make this as fair as possible, we would need to let everyone that this space is available for rental and allow whoever wants it to apply

a. Bryan agrees

- 3. Walid: we could allow stemness view to store their belongings there, while allowing students to still book it
  - a. Tamara has concerns about technology being stored there; needs to be secure
- 4. Tamara: We still have one other room that can be presented to other clubs, or can be used as study room for students to book
- Main campus was considered but due to COVID-19, office spaces aren't being given out to new organizations
- Walid: We can vote on a conditional yes; if no other clubs come forth with objections, then we can proceed

with the yes; if someone objects, then we can revisit the motion

- vii. Marah will write up a lease agreement to make everything
   official no payment involved
- viii. Vote everyone in favor of the Stemness View to occupy one of the office spaces owned by the TMMSA
  - Results: 8 voted yes, 2 voted against, 2 vote abstain
     Motion passed
